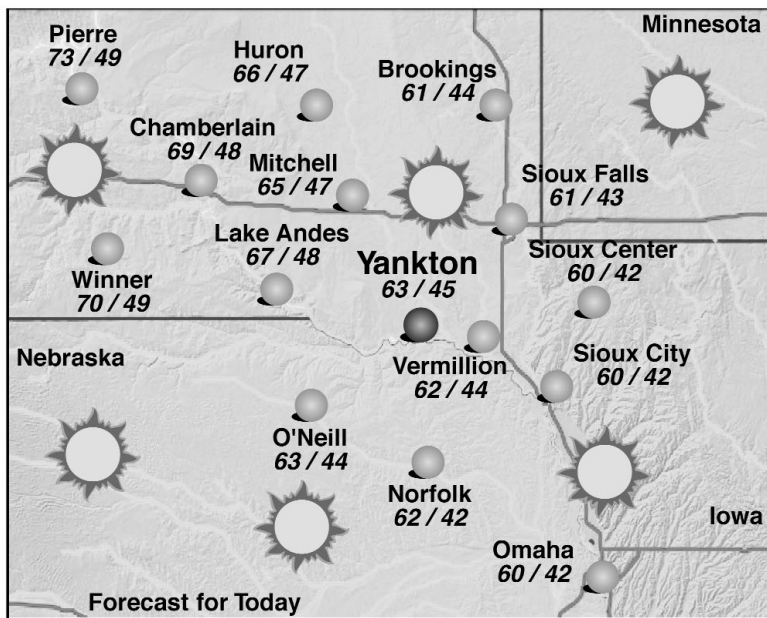
Yankton's Forecast
