## Mead Update

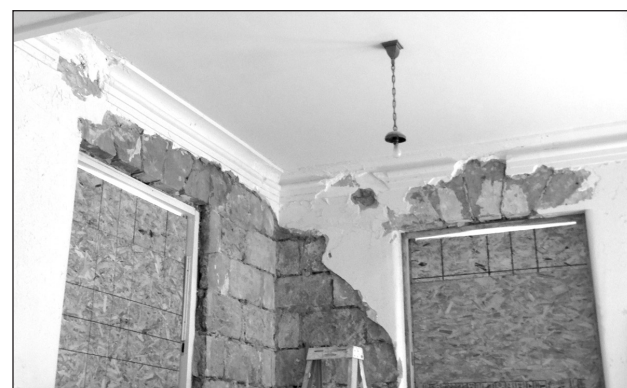
