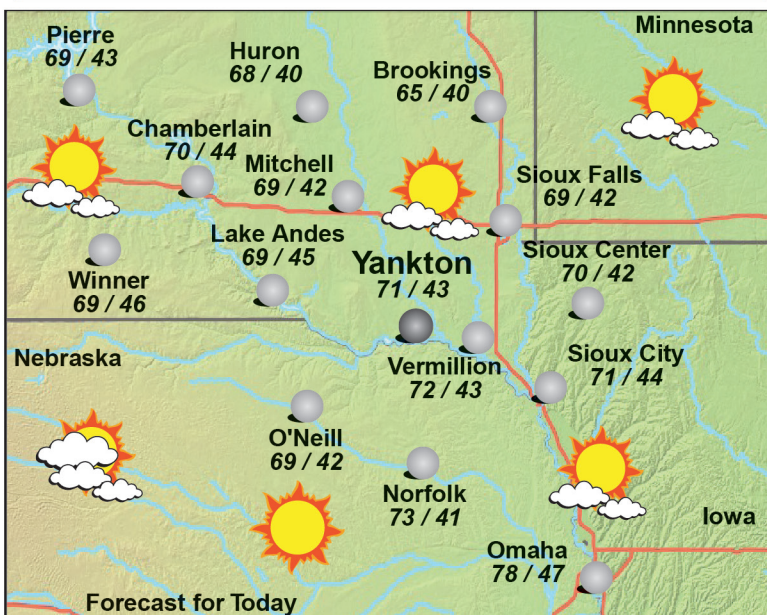

House Numbering Must Meet Requirements

The City of Yankton reminds property owners that emergency personnel as well as delivery services depend on address numbers being displayed properly. When doing exterior maintenance chores this summer, be sure to check the visibility of your house numbering.

City Ordinance requires all buildings display numbers on the door or front of the structure that are a minimum of 3 inches in height and are visible and legible from the street immediately in front of the building. Numbering on mailboxes, in landscaping or on curbs is not sufficient.

BOARD OF TRADE

CHICAGO (AP) — Grain futures were mixed Wednesday on the Chicago Board of Trade.

Wheat for December delivery was declined 9.50 cents to \$5.1675 a bushel; December corn fell 2.50 cents to 3.9575 a bushel; December oats were .25 cent higher at 2.1925 a bushel; while November soybeans rose 3 cents to \$8.91 a bushel.

Beef was higher and pork was lower on the Chicago Mercantile Exchange. December live cattle was up 2.93 cents to \$136.15 a pound; November feeder cattle gained 3.20 cents to \$18.122 a pound; while December lean hogs fell .75 cent to \$.6597 a pound.

Tuesday, October 8, 1940

- Nightlong German bombing raids on southern England were reported today by the high command, which admitted that British bombers had inflicted casualties and military damage on Berlin in a fierce exchange of air blows.
- It was announced by County Auditor Leonard A. Brown today that he has decided to provide a separate registration board for Yankton College to take registration of male college students between the ages of 21 and 36 for selective military service on October 16.

50 YEARS AGO

Friday, October 8, 1965

- A fire whipped by high winds completely destroyed a large double corn crib and some 800 bushels of corn, along with corn shelling equipment and two trucks, on a farm operated by James Adam, about six miles west of Yankton, Thursday afternoon.
- The board of directors of the Yankton county chapter of the American Red Cross decided Thurs., afternoon to try holding the rural fund drive in Yankton county during March each year instead of to coincide with the United Fund Drive in Yankton. March is National Red Cross month.
