Praying With The Plural You

It was the fall of 1994. I was at a stewardship workshop at the Holiday Inn in Detroit Lakes, MN. I was sitting on the veranda of my 2nd floor room, doing some journaling with my Bible. I was using a felt tip pen to write with. I dropped the cap of the pen, into some bushes below. (That's a problem, with a felt tip pen, because without a cap, the felt tip will dry out.) No problem, I'll find it! I went down, and searched the bushes, and I couldn't find it. What to do? I prayed, and looked again. Still no cap! Going back to my room

Jerry Salveson, my roommate, was there. I told him the problem. He said, "Let's pray about it." We prayed that I would find the cap. I went back to the bushes, and there was the cap. I will never forget Jerry's smile, as he stood on the veranda, and saw me find that cap. His smile said, "See what happens when we pray!" I have seen it, time and time again, what happens when I pray, with someone else, versus praying by myself. I don't know why, only that when people pray together, there are answers that don't appear when I pray

In both the Biblical languages of Hebrew and Greek, they make a

distinction between a singular "you", and a plural "you" ("you all") that our English language doesn't make. In the above verse, the "you" is a plural "you"-a group of believers praying together. Time and time again, in the Bible, versus that we take as singular "you's" are plural "you's." So here's your challenge to experiment with prayer! Try praying with other believers and watch what happens.

As you walk your path of life that Jesus has set in front of you, one thing is clear: KROP—Keep Right On Praying! You all will be glad you all did!
