Brothers In Music

Voice Behind 'Constant Sorrow' Teams With Songwriter For Show At Schiferl Ranch

FORDYCE, Neb. — Jen and Greg Schiferl have brought in some big acts to WJ Ranch near Fordyce, Neb., in the past. Some of the names include Michael Martin Murphy, Red Steagall and Willie and the Wild West.

But Jan readily admits that they may have set the bar high this time by bringing in Grammy Award winner Dan Tyminski, who is best known for his rendition of "Man of Constant Sorrow" in the Coen Brothers' movie "O Brother, Where Art Thou?" and Ronnie Brown, who has written songs for country music star Kenny Chesney and Brooks and Dunn, for a show on Sept. 18. Showtime is 8 p.m.

"The groups we have brought in before were great, but this is a neat level of talent and it's a notch up from before," Jan Schiferl said.

Tyminski and Brown used to be bandmates about 20 years ago when both of them played with the Lonesome River Band, with whom Brown still plays. Tyminski is currently a member of Alison Krauss and Union Station.

"We are big Alison Krauss and Union Station

fans, and the Lonesome River Band is a great band in its own right. Between those two, we are covering two of the top bluegrass bands," Schiferl said. "We've been trying for a couple of years to bring them in, and I am really excited."

The fact that the show is in a large barn is one of the things that drew Tyminski to play at WJ Ranch.

"I grew up in a small town in Vermont and going to shows in a small farm or backyard," Tyminski said. "I should be very comfortable playing at the ranch. The area is new to me, but hopefully it's not the only time I get to see it."

Tyminski is also glad he gets to team up once again with Brown, which isn't something they get to do often.

"We have done this six to eight times, I think, and we will take future dates as they make sense," he said. "Ronnie and I have a long history of singing together. We found an opportunity to sing some songs and we were able to make it happen."

Tyminski and Brown work so well together

■ "I got to record ('Man of Constant Sorrow') with (George Clooney) one day, and I played guitar and he sang it, and he could've done it. He did take a pass on it and said to me, 'I'll act, you sing.'"
