according to hall director Dan Rohmiller, but he said it's not because of the price.

"Students were excited about it, but they weren't able to see the finished product of it," he said. "Now current students and incoming students see it, and they are really impressed by it."

Rohmiller added that not being completely full is also less stressful for his staff.

"This lets us get to where we need to be, and we can work out the kinks and not be overwhelmed," he said.

Students are apparently impressed with the new style of living at USD because Rohmiller said he has been getting in applications for next year on his desk already.

"I am sure it will be full next year, and we are still taking applications for this year," he said.

Coyote Village also has a convenience store in the building, a SMART classroom, a gaming room and a theater that can seat 30 people.

"The pool table and gaming room have been in use since it's been open," Rohmiller said. "Every night, there is someone using the movie theater."

Hemeyer said he has watched several movies in the theater so far.

Coyote Village has only been open for a couple of weeks, but Rohmiller said the building is already making an impact on campus.

"The first batch of freshmen that walked by, they just stared at it. They want to stick around and live here," he said. "It's a big deal that we have it, and it's a sense of pride because USD has something like this and other universities don't."

to frame his fall campaign argument against the Republicans — that they're the rich and against working people.

"The bottom line is this: These guys, they just don't want to give up on that economic philosophy that they have been peddling for most of the last decade," Obama said. "You know that philosophy: You cut taxes for millionaires and billionaires; you cut all the rules and regulations for special interests; and then you just cut working folks loose."

"Well, you know what, that philosophy didn't work out so well for middle-class families all across America. It didn't work out so well for our country. All it did was rack up record deficits and result in the worst economic crisis since the Great Depression."

Republicans called Obama's proposal more of the same.
