Gov. Rounds Asks For Flags At Half-Mast In Honor Of Patriot Day

PIERRE— The White House has issued a Proclamation designating Saturday, Sept. 11, 2010, as Patriot Day and National Day of Service and Remembrance.

President Obama calls for the flag of the United States to be displayed at half-staff on Saturday, and he has invited Governors of the United States and the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico to join in the observance.

South Dakota Gov. Mike Rounds asks that all flags in the state be flown at half-staff on Saturday, from 8 a.m. until sunset to honor those lost during the terrorist attacks on the United States on Sept. 11, 2001.

Wheat for December delivery dropped 14 cents to \$7.24 a bushel; December corn dipped 0.25 cent to \$4.705 a bushel; December oats added 3.25 cents to \$3.18 a bushel, while soybeans for November delivery slid 12.5 cents to \$10.335 a bushel.

Beef and pork futures traded flat or higher on the Chicago Mercantile Exchange.

October live cattle added 0.25 cent to 97.15 cents a pound; October feeder cattle gained 0.45 cent to \$1.1220 a pound; October lean hogs rose 0.20 cent to 77.57 cents a pound; and February pork bellies were flat at \$1.0570 a pound.
