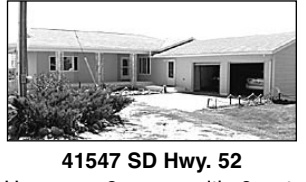

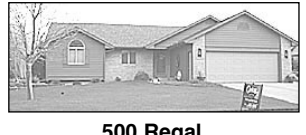

**TransCanada**  
Will Move  
100K  
Barrels/Day  
From Mont,  
N.D.

**BILLINGS, Mont.** — TransCanada Corp. said Monday that it would ship 100,000 barrels of oil daily from Montana and North Dakota under a proposal to allow U.S. crude onto a planned Canadian pipeline. The Keystone XL pipeline was proposed primarily to transport crude from Alberta's oil sands to refineries in Oklahoma and Texas. But Calgary-based TransCanada on Monday launched a two-month "open season" to solicit bids from companies that want to tap into its Keystone XL pipeline as it passes through Baker, Mont.

The announcement followed complaints from producers in the Bakken oil field of Montana and North Dakota that they were being bypassed by the new pipeline.

TransCanada Vice President Paul Miller the company plans to invest \$140 million in a new project, Bakken Marketlink, that would allow domestic oil onto its Keystone XL pipeline as it passes through Baker, Mont.

The Bakken has been described as the fastest-growing oil play in the country. Production is expected to more than double in coming year.

Yet oil companies in North Dakota and Montana currently sell crude from the region at sharply discounted prices because of a shortage of pipeline capacity. "The Bakken Marketlink is TransCanada's response to this growing demand," Miller said. He added that the size of the project could grow depending on how much crude companies want to transport.

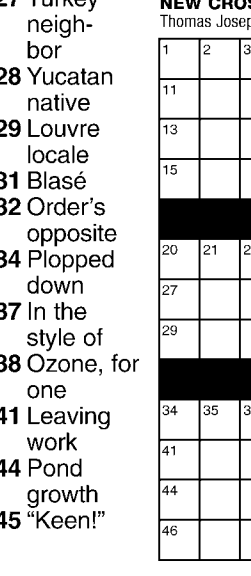

**S.D. Scores High On SATs**

**SIoux FALLS (AP)** — A report released Monday says that mean scores on the SAT college entrance exam for South Dakota students are higher than the national scores, though it's an elite pool because the vast majority of the state's high schoolers take the ACT exam. Only 234 South Dakota students took the SAT before graduating in 2010, and their mean scores were 592 for reading, 603 for math and 571 for writing. Those students' mean grade point average was 3.79. Scores for the nearly 1.6 million SAT takers across the country, whose mean GPA was 3.34, were 501 for reading, 516 for math and 492 for writing. The College Board, which administers the test, says national scores held steady this year after a slight downward trend over the previous five years.

**Weight Teasing Can Cause Issues**

**LINCOLN, Neb. (AP)** — New research suggest that teasing pre-teenagers about their weight can cause other health and emotional issues. Timothy Nelson is an assistant professor of psychology at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln and is lead author of the study. He says children are sensitive about their body image well before adolescence. He says the new research suggests that the teasing is an important social factor that could affect how pre-adolescents interpret the physical reality of their bodies. Nelson also says early identification of children who are teased may also be important in reducing the teasing and its harmful effects.

**USDA Publishes County Data In Neb.**

**LINCOLN, Neb. (AP)** — County-by-county figures on 2010 cash rent for Nebraska agricultural land again has been compiled by the U.S. Department of Agriculture's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The data are available online at [www.nass.usda.gov](http://www.nass.usda.gov) through Quick Stats, an ag statistics database. The data include average rental rates for pasture and nonirrigated and irrigated farmland for this year.

**Children's Museum of S.D. Opens**

**BROOKINGS (AP)** — South Dakota's first children's museum is open for business. The Children's Museum of South Dakota opened in Brookings on Sunday. Officials say the interactive museum focuses on learning through play. One of the main attractions is a life-size mechanical Tyrannosaurus rex dinosaur. The museum is in a renovated school building. Construction began two years ago.

**Nonprofits' Exemptions In Jeopardy**

**LINCOLN, Neb. (AP)** — The Internal Revenue Service is warning nonprofit groups that they could lose their tax exemptions if they don't file tax returns. The Lincoln Journal Star reports that more than 2,200 nonprofits in Nebraska are in jeopardy because they haven't filed returns for the past three years. Under a federal law passed in 2006, nonprofits with annual receipts of less than \$25,000 must file tax returns. The law gave the IRS power to revoke the exemption if nonprofits didn't file returns for three straight years. Last year was the third filing year since the law took effect. The IRS says groups that didn't file can get an extension through Oct. 15. The extension also is being offered to organizations whose annual receipts are between \$25,000 and \$500,000.
