Norfolk Tops Freshmen Bucks 33-13

Norfolk used a big second quarter to defeat the Yankton Bucks 33-13 in a freshman football action on Thursday afternoon in Yankton.

The visitors scored 16 points in the frame and led 28-6 after three quarters.

In the loss for Yankton (0-2), Shay Robinson returned a fumble for a touchdown and J.J. Henja scampered for a 19-yard touchdown run in the fourth quarter.

Mitch Mueller led the YHS offense with 76 yards rushing on one carry, while Hejns added 34 yards on the ground. Hejns, the team's quarterback, was 3-9 for 63 yards.

Defensively, Ty Hauger led the Bucks with nine tackles, while Cody Hanzlik made seven stops, and both Alex Dangler and Yankton recorded sacks. Isaac Althoff also blocked a punt.

Robinson travels to Mitchell next Thursday for a 4:15 p.m. kick-off.
