experiments from cosmic radiation. A \$29 million grant from the NSF to the University of California, Berkeley is being used to develop a preliminary plan, with the South Dakota School of Mines and Technology in Rapid City as one subcontractor.

In early 2011, the NSF-funded design will be presented to the 25-member National Science Board, which will decide whether to move forward with a final design and take the deep lab to Congress for funding.

South Dakota has already spent \$65 million to convert the old mine into the Sanford Underground Laboratory at Homestake, where experiments have started at 4,800 feet underground. State officials hope the foundation will take over funding by May.

early voting. "We're going to hit it hard, hard, hard," said Yankton County Republican Party Vice Chairperson Charlii Gilson.

Voters have until Oct. 18 to register to vote, Jones noted.

Currently, there are 13,530 active voters. Of those, 5,891 are registered as Republicans; 5,275 are Democrats; 2,316 are independents; 32 are Libertarians; seven are Constitution Party members; and nine are "other."

"The gap between the Democrats and the Republicans for quite a number years was in the Republicans' favor by about 1,000 voters," Jones said. "In the 2008 election, we saw that gap dwindle to probably 200-300 — the least I've ever seen it."
