MINNEAPOLIS (AP) — Minnesota Vikings defensive tackle Kevin Williams and three others have been suspended for the first two games of the regular season for violating the league's policy on performance-enhancing substances, ending a three-year court fight.

Also suspended Friday were New Orleans defensive end Will Smith and two players currently without teams: DT Pat Williams and DE Charles Grant. The league announced the suspensions six days before the Saints open the season at Green Bay and nine days before the Vikings open at San Diego on Sept. 11. The players initially were suspended for four games before the court struggle ensued, but the league reduced that suspension and fined all of them an additional two game checks.

Rucker's pass in stride and ran 80 yards for a turn-around touchdown and a 12-0 Buck lead.

"We were going to try to stick a dagger," said Likness. "That was a good read and he put it right there."

"Back to back, those were two key things - stopping them at the one and pushing them back and scoring right away," added Likness.

The Bucks added another score with 40 seconds before the half.

Rucker found Connor Fitzsimmons over the middle and at the goal line for a 17-yard touchdown hookup, giving Yankton a 20-0 lead.

That 2-minute drill drive was kept alive as Huron was caught with 12 men on the field during a Yankton punt, giving the Bucks a drive-sustaining first down.

The Bucks opened the second half with a quick-strike score, driving sixty yards in four plays and 46 seconds.

Rucker opened with a 24 yard pass to Fitzsimmons and finished with a 28-yard pitch and catch to Evan Schroeder, who took a short pass along the sideline, forced a Tiger tackler to miss, and turned back inside and toward the endzone.

The 26-0 lead stood until the end as an easier connection from Zwanziger to a wide-open Carr in the endzone failed in the fourth quarter.

"They got some yardage and they made some plays, but the defense rose up when they

needed to," said Likness of the stout unit.

The Bucks totaled seven sacks in the game and got interceptions from Fitzsimmons and Alex McKee. Ty Soulek had nine tackles while McKee had seven stops.

Rucker passed for a school-record 315 yards on 18 completions and 25 attempts. The former Yankton passing high was 312 yards.

Fitzsimmons led Yankton with 97 yards on six catches as Schroeder had six catches for 92 yards and Pasco had two catches for 92 yards.

Hott led Huron with 13 tackles and two sacks.

Zwanziger passed for 129 yards as Carr caught two passes for 43 yards and Michael Johnson had two catches for 48 yards.

Deion Faulks ran for 62 yards on 10 carries.

The Bucks face their first road test of the season as they travel to Watertown next week for a Friday night tilt with the Arrows.

EAST LANSING, Mich. (AP) — B.J. Cunningham caught nine passes for 130 yards and a touchdown, moving into a tie for first on Michigan State's career receptions list in the No. 17 Spartans' 28-6 victory over Youngstown State on Friday night.

Kirk Cousins threw for 222 yards for Michigan State, which tied for the Big Ten title last season but wasn't especially dominant against the Penguins of the Football Championship Subdivision. The Spartans led 14-6 in the third quarter when Cousins threw an 18-
