This year, the Cavalier Clash will be no different. Hosted by Bon Homme High School, the 16-team battle royale has drawn a ton of volleyball talent to Tyndall. Six of those teams were recognized in this week's South Dakota Sportswriters Association volleyball poll. In Class A, Wagner is ranked third, Bon Homme is tied for ninth and Vermillion is receiving votes. In Class B, second-ranked Parker and fifth-ranked Viborg-Hurley will take the floor, with Alcester-Hudson receiving votes.
