AP: Marlins' Nunez Faces ID Issue

(MIAMI AP) — Florida Marlins closer Leo Nunez has been playing under an assumed name, and the issue prompted him to return Thursday to his native Dominican Republic, two people familiar with his immigration status said. Both people said the Marlins have been aware of the issue for several months. They spoke to The Associated Press on condition of anonymity because Dominican and team officials haven't made any public comment on the case. One of the people said Nunez's real name is Juan Carlos Oviedo and he's 29, a year older than listed in the team media guide. The Marlins placed Nunez on Major League Baseball's restricted list, and he isn't expected to pitch in the final week of the season. His agent, Andy Mota, declined to comment. The Marlins traveled Thursday to Milwaukee for their final road series of the season.

Nunez has 36 saves and a 4.06 ERA in 68 games this year. His ERA was 2.59 in late May but is 6.00 since then.

Big 12 Commissioner Beebe Out

(NORMAN, Okla. AP) — The Big 12 dumped his embattled commissioner Thursday and said nine schools had pledged to give their TV rights to the conference for the next six years, a step intended to preserve a fractured league that has lost two members in the past year and is expected to lose another by next summer. "The bottom line is we achieved substantial reforms," Oklahoma President David Boren said after school presidents met by telephone for more than an hour. "We feel extremely good." Anil Gollahani, Oklahoma's general counsel, said no contracts had been signed yet — in part because some schools must get the approval of their governing boards. Commissioner Dan Beebe is gone after five up-and-down years that included securing a 13-year, \$1.2 billion contract with Fox Sports but leaving criticism for failing to keep Nebraska (Big Ten) and Colorado (Pac-12) from departing over the summer. Texas A&M

plans to leave by July for the Southeastern Conference.

Obama Invites '85 Bears To White House

(WASHINGTON AP) — President Barack Obama is showing some love for his home-town Chicago Bears. A White House official says the president is inviting members of the Bears 1985 Super Bowl championship team to the White House on Oct. 7. Super Bowl champions are traditionally honored with a visit to the White House. But plans for the 1985 Bears to come to Washington were scrapped when the space shuttle Challenger exploded just days after their victory in January 1986. Obama is an ardent fan of his hometown team. He somewhat begrudgingly hosted the Bears' rival, the Green Bay Packers, at the White House this year after their Super Bowl win. The official spoke on the condition of anonymity because the event has not officially been announced.
