

Despite the projected price tag, the commission agreed that the projects are needed and there is no point in trying to put them off to a later date.

ance for Michael Clark so he can move a home onto an existing foundation by Oct. 15. The structure is at 44635 Highway 50, Mission Hill. "If it is not on that founda-

tion, Yankton County will have the authority to go in and remove that house and the foundation," Zoning Administrator Pat Garrity said. The house has been on the property since 1998, and the

oundation was done in 1999. Clark said some personal issues got in the way of completing the project. A red pickup also had to be removed from the property by Sept. 1, and Clark said Tues-
