Marriage And Happiness

"Marriage, the Highest Halls of Human

- The late Peter Marshall in the book and film, a Man called Peter.

For the third time I am starting to prepare this article for the Pastor's Page. At first, I felt compelled to write about a rail disaster in Canada and the investigation following (I worked in the railroad industry for a period of 15 years). Concluding that this would be better as an editorial, I looked at the foundations of the Faith and prepared to comment on them (redemption, resurrection and His return). However, after celebrating our 57th wedding anniversary Sept. 8 and joining another family's celebration of their 60th the day before, some comments and observations from Holy Scripture may be more appropriate.

To say the least, we are living in changing times. Back in my college days in the 1950s, the Pledge of Allegiance was changed to add the words "under God" with no opposition that I can recall. Today in Massachusetts I understand the issue is before the courts to remove that phrase. Growing up in the '40s, divorce was almost unheard of in our neighborhood. After the courts adopted the policy of "no fault divorce" in the 1960's it has become all too common. As commitments made in the marriage ceremony fail, it would seem that the ceremony should have started with the processional being 'Sound the Battle Cry" and the recessional "The Fight Is On."

that I have found maintaining a Christian marriage to be the biggest challenge of my life. It is not always easy, but believe me, it is worth it! I thank God

for a dedicated Christian wife.

I served in Iowa on the board of one of Iowa's larger churches. I asked the pastor what we were doing about the problems of addiction and anger we were seeing vented in the community. His reply, the break-up of family is the common cause underneath all of these problems. are designed to compliment each other by a designer that only befits the infinite mind of our Creator.

From the Ten Commandments, the Fifth Commandment reads to honor your father and mother. Jesus refers to the creation of male and female when discussing divorce with the Jews (Matt. 19:4-5). "And He answered and sail to them, have you not read that he who made them at the beginning made them male and female, And said for this cause shall a man leave father and mother and shall cleave to his wife, and they twain shall be one flesh?"

As marriage is summed up, leave and cleave. The bride and groom cease to be accountable to their parents and become accountable to God, as their parents are also. There is no prohibition to honor their parents, but they are to obey God, with the man held accountable to love his wife as Christ loved the Church and the bride to her husband. I believe this comes from the principle that no one can serve two masters, for he will come to hate one and love the other. I believe that honoring and following these basic premises will only build respect and love for all parties involved.

As we look at our lives and see where we are today, we must all realize that we cannot change the past. But Jesus invites us to come to Him just as we are, for He loves us so much that He has the power to bring about necessary changes in the future. 'Therefore if any man be in Christ: he is a new creature: old things are passed away, all things are becoming new." — II Corinthians
