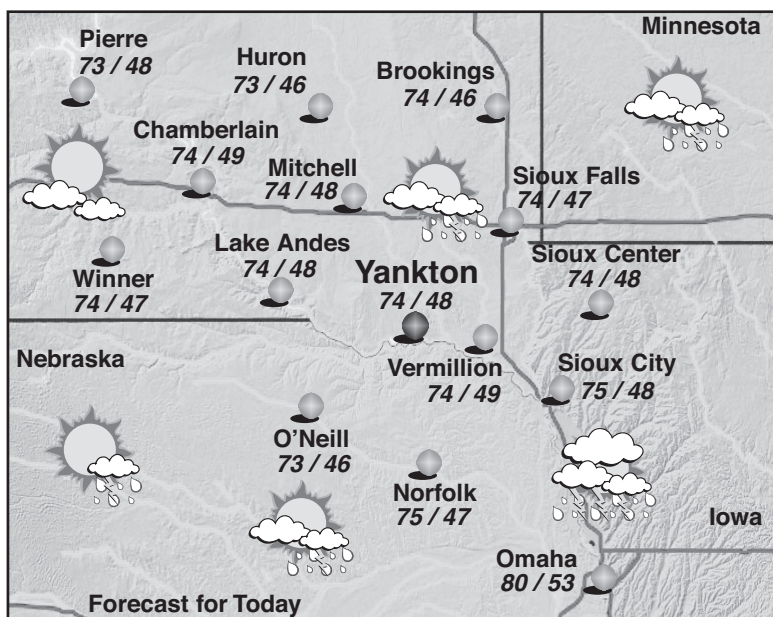

SHERIFF'S REPORT

• On Sept. 12, 2013, at 9:26, the Knox County Sheriff's Office investigated a one vehicle accident 3 miles east of Verdigr on Highway 64. Regina Paest, driving westbound on the highway, struck three calves, owned by Cully Forker, Verdigr. Paest was not injured. The three calves were killed and the damage to Paest's vehicle was estimated to be \$5,000.

• On Sept. 13, 2013, a report was received of an accident involving a semi-tractor approximately 7 1/2 miles north of Bloomfield, on 543rd AVE. A power pole had been struck and power lines were on top of the semi. The scene was entered once the power had been shut down by Cedar Knox Public Power District, and the scene was safe. The semi was removed from the scene and the power pole and lines were replaced. The driver was identified as Tony Miller of Corsica. Bloomfield Fire and Rescue units responded to the scene.

• On Sept. 13, 2013 a report was

received from Alice Gilsdorf of a possible phone scam. The caller said he was from the Social Security Office and new Social Security cards were being sent out and he needed to verify some information. The caller asked for bank account information but none was given. A check with the Social Security Office in Norfolk confirmed that this was not a legitimate call.

• On Sept. 14, 2013, a report was received of a hit and run accident south of Verdigr, on Highway 14, near the construction barricades. A white van was located nearly 1,000 feet from the damaged property. The investigation showed the van having damage consistent with that of the barricade. The vehicle was towed and is being held as evidence, pending the rest of the investigation. Charges are being requested from the Knox County Attorney.

• On Sept. 15, 2013, a report was received from Dan Vakoc that road barricades located on the gravel road north of Center had been knocked over.
