Mayor's Prayer Breakfast Oct. 11

Oct. 11 will mark the fifth year of the Yankton Area Mayor's Prayer Breakfast, which has its roots in the Sioux Falls Mayor's Prayer Breakfast, which is approaching its 40-year mark.

"Five years ago, then-Sioux Falls mayor Dave Munson spoke briefly at our first breakfast, affirming the positive impact prayer has had on that city," said Loretta Sorensen, one of the breakfast organizers. "We thought if he was willing to drive for more than an hour and be in Yankton for a 7 a.m. breakfast we could do whatever was necessary to hold the breakfast each year.

The idea for the breakfast grew out of Sorensen's appreciation for the 2008 Sioux Falls breakfast she attended. Yankton's first prayer breakfast committee included former South Dakota resident Ken Korkow, who now lives in Omaha. Korkow serves as regional director of Christian Business Men's Committee (CBMC) Heartland, serving Nebraska, Iowa and South Dakota. The breakfast, which he helped the first committee launch, is modeled after CBMC prayer breakfasts that are held in cities across the United States.

"Ken and his wife drove from Omaha to attend a couple of our first organizational meetings," said Julie Auch, breakfast committee member. "His insight and encouragement for getting this event started in Yankton was invaluable. We still rely on him for guidance and input. As a recipient of the Navy Cross, the nation's second highest award for combat valor, Ken has his own personal ministry to members of our armed forces.

In addition to Sorensen, Auch (Menno) and Peg Wittmeier (Yankton), Don Veldhouse and several other volunteers always step up to help with the breakfast.

Sorensen says the purpose of the breakfast is to publicly acknowledge the power and value of prayer.

"If you're a football fan, you're probably familiar with the stir Tim Tebow caused when he bowed his knee and acknowledged God during games," Sorensen said. "Few people are aware that his actions motivated the Newsmax Health team to study how prayer impacts

"There are 47 scientifically

proven benefits of prayer," Sorensen said. "They include pain relief, reduced risk of death from stroke or heart attack, decreased anxiety, and more. That's the kind of blessing we want to help make available to our community.

Sioux Falls attorney Bret Merkle will speak about the significance of prayer in his life after he suffered a devastating motorcycle accident while he was in college.

"I'm not the one to tell Bret's story," Sorensen said. "During the breakfast he'll explain what God has done in his life. His story was so dramatic that he wrote a book about it, 'Tragic Blessing.' Because of his accident, Bret endured months of surgery and pain, which led him to the depths of despair. He was ready to end his life when God intervened."

Wittmeier notes that one of the elements of the prayer breakfast that people often say they appreciate are the prayers offered by members of the Yankton community for businesses, churches, families and more.

There's something very powerful about hearing your friends and

neighbors pray in a public setting," Wittmeier said. "Dave Munson em-phasized the positive effect he and his staff experienced as a result of prayers offered on their behalf. That's the kind of impact we hope to have on the Yankton community. This is our opportunity to let business owners, clergy and church leaders, government and political leaders and members of our community in general know that we care enough about them and our community to publicly stand and pray for them.

Among those participating in this year's breakfast program are Dana Forbes, Pastor Kwen Sanderson, Pastor Tracy Headley, Dr. Wayne Kindle, Chuck Haffner, Bernie Hunhoff, Don Veldhouse
