And so, I won't go so far as to say tonight's (Friday) Yankton football game against Sioux Falls O'-Gorman is a must-win. But make mistake, it's pretty dang close.

Let's put it like it is: For varying reasons, the Bucks could be in danger of missing out on the playoffs with a loss to O'Gorman.

A loss to the Knights would drop Yankton to 1-4 this season, and with three games remaining (at Watertown, home versus Pierre and at Harrisburg), the Bucks would need a late surge.

As it stands right now prior to tonight's game, Yankton sits in eighth place in the new Class 11AA division. Keep in mind, eight teams make the playoffs. The only teams behind the Bucks? Sturgis and Spearfish.

Now, to be fair, part of it is out of Yankton's control. West River teams such as Douglas, Sturgis and

Spearfish in Class 11AA play 11A teams. You never want to assume wins there, but for the sake of argument, let's call those extra wins for West River teams.

Yankton, meanwhile has four Class 11AAA teams on its schedule this year, Rapid City Stevens, Brandon Valley, Aberdeen Central and O'Gorman. Call it unfair scheduling (and you might have a gripe), but you can only control the teams on your schedule.

On the other hand, Yankton has caused some of its own problems. That season-opening loss to Mitchell (the first such in the series since 1987) looms large, as does last week's defeat in Aberdeen — a game the Bucks should have won.

Personally, I'm not sure where I stand on this issue. Yes, Yankton could have avoided any such concerns, but our state's geography — West River vs. East River — presents obstacles that an additional 11-man class can't solve.

But let's keep in mind, the Bucks can help themselves with a win tonight over O'Gorman. Start there and worry about tomorrow, well, tomorrow.

That's all you can do, right?

Rivera May Make 1st Of Appearance In Houston

NEW YORK (AP) — Mariano Rivera may make a debut on his final weekend before retirement: as a centerfielder.

The 43-year-old closer, in his 19th and final big league season, has said he'd like to play the outfield.

Yankees manager Joe Girardi says he's thinking about allowing Rivera to do it this weekend, when the Yankees finish their season with a three-game series at the Houston Astros.

Says Girardi: "In my mind, thinking that he's going to want to pitch, it would be a situation that I might bring him in (in) the eighth to play the outfield and close him out in the ninth if we have that opportunity."

Rivera missed most of the 2012 season after hurting his knee while shagging fly balls during pregame practice at Kansas City.
