time they go to school they need to have another measles vaccine unless they have a medical reason or religious ason not to get it."

Kightlinger estimated only about 1 percent of South Dakota kids have not received a dose of the measles, mumps, rubella (MMR) vaccine either due to age restrictions (it cannot be received before a child's first birthday) or religious reasons.

In a report released by the CDC Sept. 13, 159 cases of measles had been reported in 16 states between Jan. 1 and Aug. 24. No deaths have been reported yet. Of the 140 U.S. citizens it was reported in, 131 had not been vaccinated. Of those who had not, 92 (79 percent) cited "philosophical reasons" for not getting a vaccination.

Johnson said sketchy information has also been a factor in making people wary about vaccination.

"In the information age, people have a lot of access to computers," she said. "Sometimes it's hard to tell when you look up things on the computer if that is really good information or if it's information that's put together by groups that might not be the experts on vaccination."

Kightlinger said one of the main incidents that fueled online conspiracies was the publication of a report in a reputable medical journal by British doctor Andrew Wakefield.

'There was an article published in The Lancet back in (1998) about measles vaccine and autism," he said. "It was later shown the what (Dr. Wakefield) had done was a complete fraud.'

Dr. Wakefield's article claimed a link had been established between the MMR vaccine and a rise in cases of autism in children. The CDC, Institute of Medicine (IOM), United States National Academv of Sciences and the United Kingdom National Health Service all failed to find links between autism and the MMR vaccine. The Lancet has since retracted the article and Wakefield was stripped of his right to practice medicine in England in 2010.

In May, CBS News reported 1.200 cases of measles had already been reported in the U.K. this year, following a total of nearly 2,000 cases in 2012. Prior to the publication of the report, the U.K. had only reported several dozen cases each year.

Kightlinger said despite the Wakefield's study being discredited, rumors have a way of persisting.

'Once you get something like that out there and people

piggy-back on it, it becomes urban myth," he said. "Other people have joined that bandwagon too, and then it gets on the Internet and the blogosphere. It's really difficult to get the facts out and try to show people the scientific evidence because once some people have something in their heads, true or not, that's it.

He added that medical practitioners are always on the lookout for issues in vaccines.

"In public health we're very concerned with science," he said. "We're always looking for bad things too. If there's a vaccine out there that's not working or not doing what it's supposed to be doing or (if it's) harming people, there are mechanisms to pull that off (the market) and shut it down.'

Johnson also added that some people have a tendency to equate a lack of reported cases to a sense of security.

"When people don't see the actual disease, then they start thinking, 'Well do I really need to get vaccinated?" she said. "They don't see it as that big of a threat."

Kightlinger said that vaccinations are extremely safe and that they are better than taking any risks.

The vaccines are as safe as they can be," he said. "They're very low risk but most of the risk is getting a sore arm or a red arm or something like that around where the shot was given. It's a lot safer than letting your child get the actual disease. We used to have bad situations in South Dakota deaths and people who became deaf, people who had permanent brain injury because of measles — and we don't have that anymore because of the vaccine. I don't want to go back to those days

again. Johnson said talking to a doctor is the best course of action for anyone with questions about vaccination.

"For parents who have questions about it, their best source of information is not so much the Internet or things like that, but talking to their healthcare provider," she said.

In addition to healthcare providers, Kightlinger said there are numerous sources that people can use for questions about vaccines including the CDC.

"The CDC is our most trusted word (in medicine) because that's above the frav.' he said. "The CDC does not manufacture or sell vaccines or promote brands.

square footage," Herbster said. "You just won't have it stacked one on top of each other. Everything we wanted in there will still be in there.'

Herbster said USD is working with two design firms, Populous (which has offices in Kansas City and Denver) and Architecture Inc. of Sioux Falls, and that the design stages are an "ongoing process.

The one thing that has not changed, though, is USD's fundraising push, Herbster said — though the A.D. admitted he wished he had more "bodies to throw at this."

"I knew in this process the first half would come relatively quickly, then the next quarter you would have to slug it out, and the last quarter you're really going to have to bear down and work harder," he said.

Certain anonymous gifts have continued to trickle in, including a recent \$100,000 gift for the track complex, Herbster said.

Because of the layout of the track and soccer complex, a number of other athletic teams — including intramurals - would be affected.

The new soccer stadium (with a nearby practice field) would be located where the current football practice fields are, while the new outdoor track would be located along University Street west of the new soccer location, near where USD holds intramural practices and games for students.

Two new synthetic football practice fields are planned for the area north of the DakotaDome, as well, where the current soccer field sits.

In the meantime, USD's athletic department and Foundation staff will continue to seek donations, Herbster said.

"Over the next six months we'll have to hit it hard," he said. "Even once we start digging, we'll still continue to raise money. But you've got to start to build at some point in time.

"The cost of construction isn't going to get any lower, and interest rates on those bonds will only go up."

He said the latest estimates show 95 percent of the expected 2015 federal highway funding will be needed just to cover projects already in the pipeline across the nation. In 2008 federal highway

officials said they could

cover only 50 percent of the bills being submitted for projects. "That created chaos

among the states," Bergquist said.

Congress began supplementing the highway program with general funds, which really meant borrowing more money. Five years later Congress still hasn't reached an answer about how to handle that problem too.

Bergquist briefed members of the state Transportation Commission about the situation at their meeting Thursday.

"You used the term 'iron out," commissioner Sam Tidball of Fort Pierre told him. "I think they're working with a pretty cold iron."

Bergquist said routine operations in South Dakota such as winter snow-plowing won't be affected if there is a federal government shutdown.
