## 5 Children Dead; Father Detained

CAMDEN, Ala. (AP) — A man is suspected of killing his five children in South Carolina and then driving all the way to Alabama before dumping their bodies on a dirt road and fleeing to Mississippi, authorities said. Following his arrest, he led police to the site where the lifeless children were found wrapped in individual plastic bags.

Timothy Ray Jones Jr., 32, was charged with unlawful neglect by a legal custodian and police expect to file additional charges as the investigation develops, Lexington County, South Carolina, Sheriff Lewis McCarty said in a statement.

Jones was being held in Smith County, Mississippi, and awaiting extradition to South Carolina, the Mississippi Bureau of Investigation said in a news release. Wilcox County, Alabama, District Attorney Michael Jackson told The Associated Press that Jones is suspected of killing the children in South Carolina and leaving their bodies in a rural area near Camden, Alabama.

The children ranged from 1 to 8 years old and were reported missing by their mother on Sept. 3, authorities said.

"This is a very tragic situation," Jackson said. "These kids' lives were snuffed out before they had a chance to enjoy life. Justice will be served."

Police have not released details on how the children died.

None accepted.

Tyler on Tuesday said she would take her information to the attorney general. He is a Republican.

Tyler later Tuesday morning tried to reopen the EB-5 discussion with the Executive Board about how to handle such matters that come to a legislator's attention.

Brown in turn called on a member of the Legislative Research Council staff to distribute photocopies of two pages from Mason's Manual, one of the ruling documents used by the Legislature for its procedures.

Brown referred specifically to rule 797, section 1: "The legislature has no right to conduct an investigation for the purpose of laying a foundation for the institution of criminal proceedings, for the aid and benefit of grand juries in planning indictments, for the purpose of intentionally injuring such persons or for any other ulterior purpose."

The next several pages lay out how legislative investigations should and shouldn't function and for what purposes they can and can't be used.

Brown is the president pro tem, the highest ranking senator in that chamber. His position was supported by House Speaker Brian Gosch, R-Rapid City.

Gosch used the phrase "political grandstanding" in regard to Tyler's efforts Tuesday.

"I am not political grandstanding," Tyler responded. Democratic candidates and office holders in recent weeks have made EB-5 the spear of their fall election campaigns against Republicans.

The Legislature adopted a resolution last winter that asked GOAC "to conduct hearings on issues related to the Governor's Office of Economic Development" and to issue a report no later than Dec. 1.

GOAC's next scheduled meeting is Sept. 24. An agenda hasn't been posted yet.

For many legislators and citizens, EB-5 was something they hadn't know about prior to last fall.

EB-5 is a federally author-

ized program that lets businesses and governments establish regional centers that match projects with foreign investors.

The program is intended to allow foreign nationals to put at least \$500,000 at risk in attempts to create U.S. jobs.

The investors in return can qualify for visa status that allows them and their families to live anywhere in the United States.

In South Dakota, state government holds the regional center status. EB-5 gradually expanded into a major yet largely secret tool for economic development during the Rounds administration from 2003 through 2010.

During Rounds' second term, EB-5 activities were completely privatized through a 2009 contract with Bollen after he left SDIBI to be full-time president of his EB-5 company called SDRC.

The other man signing the 2009 contract was Richard Benda, who in 2006 became secretary of tourism and state development for Rounds.

Under the contract state government received small percentages of the fees that SDRC charged the foreign investors.

Jackley and Gov. Daugaard revealed last year that Jackley was investigating Benda.

That probe was triggered by a federal grand jury subpoena delivered to Daugaard's office in March 2013.

Information about Benda's travel activities while secretary was among eight items sought by the grand jury.

The other seven haven't been publicly revealed. No federal charges have been brought.

Last September, the Daugaard administration terminated the Benda-Bollen contract, as more was learned from Jackley's investigation.

No new EB-5 investment projects have been started since then under state government's direct management.

None of this was publicly known as it was happening, however.

It started coming to public knowledge after Benda's body was found Oct. 22, 2013. Authorities determined he died Oct. 20 of a shotgun wound to his abdomen. They declared it consistent with suicide.
