The University of South Dakota women's basketball team picked up another recruit that stands over six feet tall. Madeline Homoly, a 6-foot-2 post from Roland Park, Kansas, committed to the Coyotes on Tuesday, she announced on Twitter. Homoly, a senior at Bishop Miege High School, earned All-State honorable mention recognition in Nebraska's Class 4A. It is the same classification as another USD commit, 6-foot-1 Megan Bonar of De Soto, Kansas. Commitments are not binding until athletes sign their National Letter of Intent.

USD's Eichhorn Earns Summit League Honors

ELMHURST, Ill. — South Dakota junior Amber Eichhorn has been named the Summit League's Women's Cross Country Athlete of the Week for the period ended Sept. 7. Eichhorn shares the

award with sophomore Brittany Beard of Fort Wayne, as released by the Summit League on Tuesday. Eichhorn records her first career Athlete of the Week honor after winning the Augustana Twilight, seven seconds ahead of the second-place finisher from Nebraska. Eichhorn led a field of 265 other competitors. The Coyotes took first place out of 22 schools in the meet, including Division I opponents Nebraska, Creighton and Omaha. Eichhorn and the rest of the Coyotes race next on Sept. 27 at the Roy Griak Invitational in Minneapolis, Minn. Eichhorn shared women's honors with Fort Wayne's Brittany Beard.
