Sacred Heart Monastery Presents 'How Do Catholics Read The Bible'

The Fall Theology Institute at Sacred Heart Monastery is the second of a series on fundamentalism, focusing on Biblical interpretation. "How Do Catholics Read the Bible?" will be presented by S. Marielle Frigge, OSB, on Saturday, Sept. 20, from 9 a.m.-noon in the Chapter Room of Sacred Heart Monastery.

S. Marielle's presentation follows the previous Theology Institute on religious fundamentalism, focusing on biblical fundamentalism and Catholic interpretation of scripture. She will explore several Catholic teaching documents on Biblical interpretation, including significant shifts in approaches to

understanding the Bible in the past 125 years, and how these changing views can affect theology and practice. As an example, she will discuss why Catholics can believe in both the Bible's account of the creation of humankind and scientific views of evolution of the human species. There will be an opportunity for questions and discussion.

After 33 years of teaching Scripture and theology at Mount Marty College, S. Marielle now arranges and

occasionally presents various opportunities for continuing education and spiritual formation for the Sacred Heart Monastery community, other religious communities and various church, parish, and ecumenical groups. S. Marielle is the author of Beginning Biblical Studies, now in second edition (2013), and writes biblical commentaries for Liturgy Training Publications, Chicago.

'What Would You Like Written?'

Somewhere I recall reading of a newspaper writer whose job it was to edit the obituary page. One day, things were slow on the job-nobody died-so he searched around for something to do. As he sat staring at the keys on his computer, he began to think about what his own obituary might look like if suddenly it became necessary to publish one. As he thought about it, he realized that there would not be very much to say beyond place of birth, job, family and so on. So he began to compose the kind of obituary for himself that he would like to have written. In it he included all sorts of church activities and community service, involvement with young people, his community, support for the various educational institutions, help with the United Way — one worthwhile activity after another. When the

obituary was finished, he was most impressed, but at the same time, most discouraged. Because he realized that what he had written was a big lie. It became a challenge to him, and for the rest of his life, that man made the effort to live up to that glowing obituary he had written. It worked. He did become involved in his church and community more than ever before, and the result finally was that the fanciful obituary he had written on one slow day proved to become a roadmap for his life. What kind of obituary would you like to have written about you?

I've discovered the best road map for life is the one laid out by Jesus

Christ. We see Jesus taking time to visit the sick, to minister to the blind, the lame, the physically and emotionally challenged. He took time for little children. He accepted the rejected and hated. He spoke out for fair play and justice. He insisted on the truth knowing that it would set people free from ignorance and failure. He showed us the importance of using our talents for worthy purposes, using our money for causes that uplift humankind, and using our time in fruitful and positive ways. He taught us how to forgive, how to take suffering and persecution, and how to say close to God no matter what happens.

I encourage you to be like Christ in every way and every day and you will know life filled to overflowing with hope and joy even in the most difficult situations! May the desire of our hearts always be not that people see us but Christ living in us and through us!
