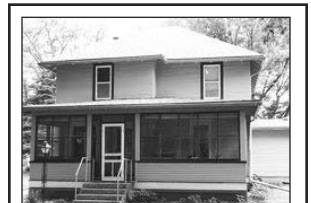

there's a lot of safety features that have been put into them that aren't in our old truck," he said. "Those safety features are being incorporated into this truck to make it a safer apparatus."

One of the new features is known as "tip-over protection."

"Sometimes you get into areas where you can't put the out-riggers out all the way," he said. "With our old truck, if we extend the ladder over the side and the out-riggers aren't fully extended, there's a chance we could tip the truck over. With the new truck, it will not allow you to rotate over that (side), therefore, you shouldn't be able to tip it over."

Other features on the truck will help boost the actual fire-fighting capability of the new truck.

"Another thing that's on there is what's called a 'load minder' and we'll know how much weight we have going on out there because there is a maximum load we can put on the tip of that ladder," Kurtenbach said. "For fire-fighting, instead of one monitor on top for flowing water, we'll have two. So we've kind of duplicated what we can do up there."

With the purchase of a new truck, attempts will be made to find a new home for the old ladder truck.

"We're going to put a flyer together and market it, send some emails out to try and see if any of the more local agencies want to purchase it," he said. "Eventually, it'll be sold as a used apparatus."

Kurtenbach said the most important part of the city's purchase of the new equipment is that it keeps the city's fire department running smoothly.

"It brings us up to date," he said. "It keeps us current with NFPA standards and insures that our equipment is reliable. ... We're just very fortunate we have a (City) Commission that's progressive and allows us to go ahead and keep up with the apparatus we need to do our job."

said to the students Monday. "As a state, we are trying to figure out what we will be when we grow up. One way to do that is to listen to the stories of what we have already done."

Adding that South Dakota should have perhaps been called what author Bob Karolevitz referred to as the "Challenge" state, Hunhoff told the students that not all of our history has been good or fun.

"One of the worst things in South Dakota history happened when our state was just one year old," he said. "That was the Wounded Knee Massacre. More than 300 native American men, women and children were killed."

His presentation included photos of other disasters, weather events and war-time perseverance — a few of the events that have made the state what it is today.

"Maybe the way to describe the state of South Dakota is to say that we can go through really hard times and get right back up and get going again," Hunhoff said.

Struck noted that Hunhoff's presentation was the kick-off for a two-month-long study of the history of the state at the school.

"One fun event will be our use of the 'M is For Mount Rushmore' book," Struck said. "Each door in the building is going to be decorated with a different letter from the book, which is dedicated to South Dakota history."

Other events that the school will be conducting will include having other speakers, touring the Dakota Territorial Museum and using books to learn about the history.
