Originally, the project had been anticipated to move forward in 2015. However, the project only received one bid when it was originally let in March of this year — a bid of \$11 million from D&G. The project was put on hold for the summer.
Rod Gall, SDDOT area engineer for Yankton, told the *Press & Dakotan* there were a few key differences in this month's approach to the project that helped it move forward.
"The project was (originally) bid from Broadway Ave. to Archery Lane," he said. "This time, we split it up. This time we're going Marne Creek to Broadway. It made the sections smaller, which gives a chance for some smaller bidders that could handle a smaller section of road a chance to bid on it. ... Also, the time of the year had a lot to do with it. Contractors, right now, are looking for work for next year and they all look at it and say, 'Well we can do that for next year because we don't have any work lined up yet.' Last spring, most of them were filled up except for the one that bid on it, and they bid on it quite high."
Rothschadl said DOT officials are glad to be moving forward.
"We were happy about it over here in the DOT," he said. "The roadway is past its lifespan and needs to be fixed."
Looking forward to phase two, Rothschadl said letting is set for some time next August or September while construction will commence in spring of 2017.
Gall said the engineer's estimate on the second phase is \$5.4 million and will rebuild Highway 50 between Marne Creek and Archery Lane.
