

WALL ST. RECAP

Fears over slowing global growth hammered stocks in the U.S. on Friday and lifted prices of government bonds and other assets seen as safer bets. The selling came a day after the Federal Reserve decided to hold interest rates near zero, citing low inflation and a weak global economy.

**ON FRIDAY:**

The Dow Jones industrial average fell 290.16 points, or 1.7 percent, to 16,384.58.

The Standard & Poor's 500 index slumped 32.17 points, or 1.6 percent, to 1,958.03.

The Nasdaq composite shed 66.72 points, or 1.4 percent, to 4,827.23.

**FOR THE WEEK:**

The Dow is down 48.51 points, or 0.3 percent.

The S&P 500 index is down 3.02 points, or 0.2 percent.

The Nasdaq is up 4.89 points, or 0.1 percent.


**FOR THE YEAR:**

The Dow is down 1,438.49 points, or 8.1 percent.

The S&P 500 index is down 100.87 points, or 4.9 percent.

The Nasdaq is up 91.17 points, or 1.9 percent.

BOARD OF TRADE

CHICAGO (AP) — Grain futures were mostly lower Friday on the Chicago Board of Trade.

Wheat for December delivery gained 5.25 cents to \$4.8675 a bushel; December corn was off 2.50 cents to 3.7725 a bushel; December oats were off 1.25 cents to 2.3050 a bushel; while November soybeans declined 17.25 cents to \$8.6725 a bushel.

Beef and pork were lower on the Chicago Mercantile Exchange. December live cattle was off .95 cent to \$1.3837 a pound; October feeder cattle fell 1.98 cents to \$1.8582 a pound; while December lean hogs lost .20 cent to \$6.415 a pound.
