there was a university committee that would engage our creativity, interests and passions without the dull monotony of something like 'assessment goals' or 'vocation standards'...

Patella said there were a number of people who came together to make the visualized Bible a possibility. "The committee itself was composed of New Testament exegete — that's myself — an Old Testament exegete, two artists, a Patristic scholar, a Medievalist, a Medieval art historian, a dogmatic theologian, a contemporary artist and an Asian art historian," he said.

The Bible took nearly a decade to complete and includes 15 images depicting events such as the Creation, the Ten Commandments, the Birth of Christ and other events from Scripture.

Brookings Man Writes Book About His Life With Polio

BROOKINGS — A Brookings man is sharing his story about living with polio. Mark Sternhagen has penned the book "Normal for Me" in which he details his life since contracting polio at 18 months old.

Sternhagen, 59, grew up in Scotland, South Dakota. He said he was the lone member of his family who wasn't vaccinated against the disease because he was less than a year old and had a fever when the vaccine came to town.

The cover of Sternhagen's book has a photo of him smiling as he tried to stand upright with crutches and iron strapped to his legs.
