BRANDON – Brandon Valley rallied from a 14-6 halftime deficit to beat Yankton 26-21 in JV football action on Monday. Garrett Tennant was 9-15 passing for 139 yards and two touchdowns, and Casey Krejci had a rushing score and a touchdown catch for Yankton. Josh Galvin-Hofer caught two passes for 75 yards, and Oakley Palmer caught three passes for 39 yards and a score for the Bucks.

Defensively, Galvin-Hofer picked off a pass and Tyler Strahl had seven tackles to lead the defense. Casey Krejci made six tackles and Carter Peterson had five stops for the Bucks.

Yankton, 5-2, hosts Norfolk on Oct. 5 at Crane-Youngworth Field. Start time is set for 4:15 p.m.

MINNEAPOLIS — Junior Yuliyia Sidenko and freshman Ellie Burns both won three matches in the top singles flight at Minnesota's Gopher Invitational held Friday through Sunday at the Baseline Tennis Center. The tournament consisted of 12 teams, including Minnesota, Wisconsin, Iowa State and Air Force. It featured three singles flights and each day held different doubles draws.

Thirty-one players competed in the top flight. Sidenko and Burns both won twice in the consolation bracket following opening-round losses. Sidenko went on to beat North Dakota's Lacey Sprinkel 8-5 in the 19th-place match Sunday. Burns downed North Dakota's Faith Lee 8-4 in the 21st-place match.

Coyote junior Emma Kranendonk, senior Milica Pavlovich and freshman Elise van Zijst competing in the 32-person B Flight for singles. Kranendonk earned a pair of straight-set wins before finishing in 14th place. Pavlovich won a 10-2 super breaker against Drake's Summer Brilless and downed North Dakota's Mimi Yunker in straight sets en route to a 20th-place finish. van Zijst also won twice and placed 23rd.

Sophomore Hannah Wich competed in the C Flight Tournament. She beat Green Bay's Noel Peck 6-0, 6-0 in an opening match and lost to Wisconsin's Nathalie Joanlanne before an injury took her out of the tournament.

Pavlovich and Kranendonk combined for two of South Dakota's four doubles victories during the weekend. The duo defeated Joanlanne and Badger teammate Sydney Rider 6-4, and also downed Milwaukee's Laurie Clark and Dana Shannon 6-2.

Pavlovich and Kranendonk improved to 6-4 in doubles play through two fall tournaments. van Zijst is 7-3 in singles play through two events. Burns, Kranendonk and Sidenko each have five singles victories each.

Milone Starts For Ill
Hughes, Pitches Twins

Past Indians 4-2

CLEVELAND (AP) — Emergency starter Tommy Milone replaced an ill Phil Hughes and pitched the Minnesota Twins past the Cleveland Indians 4-2 on Monday night in a game crucial to the wild-card chances of both clubs.

Hughes, one of several Twins players hit with a virus that has spread throughout the team, was scratched from his scheduled start about 4 hours before the game. Milone (9-5), removed from the rotation two weeks ago, stepped in an allowed two runs in 5 2-3 innings.

Minnesota (81-75) began the day trailing Houston by 1 1/2 games in the race for the second AL wild card. The Astros played later in Seattle.

The Twins entered a half-game game behind the Los Angeles Angels, who hosted Oakland in a late game.

Cleveland (77-78) was four games behind the Astros before its costly defeat.

Milone took control after giving up a solo homer to Francisco Lindor in the first inning, retiring 10 in a row during one stretch.

Trevor Plouffe, who missed Sunday's game because of the virus, hit a two-run homer in the first off Corey Kluber (8-16).

Kevin Jepsen worked the ninth for his 14th save.

Milone was sent to the bullpen following two rocky outings in which he allowed 12 runs over five innings. The left-hander is 3-1 with a 2.16 ERA in six career starts against Cleveland.

Kluber, last season's AL Cy Young Award winner, allowed four runs in six innings and lost to Minnesota for the second time in a week. The right-hander, who missed two weeks with a hamstring injury this month, hasn't won since Aug. 14.
